

A Proclamation naming November 22<sup>nd</sup> as "Lady Brahma Volleyball Day"

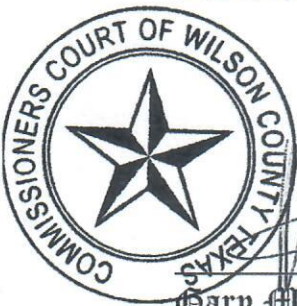


